

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE HANNEN ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge repairs and inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Norwood High Street, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Hannen Road.

2. The ban on vehicles entering Hannen Road would not apply to any vehicle requiring access to or egress from premises only accessible from Hannen Road, providing that vehicle does not interfere with or disrupt the works.

3. An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via Norwood High Street, Ernest Avenue and Knight's Hill.

4. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

5. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies, if it is deemed necessary in the interest of public safety and subject to the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs the one-way traffic system in Hannen Road would be suspended, so as to allow access to and egress from properties in Hannen Road.

6. The order would come into force on 19th January 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order would only have effect at night on 19th and 20th January 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order would also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
