

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE NEW FREE LIMITED TIME
DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES IN LOWER
MARSH

(Note: This Notice is about the provision of a new free limited time disabled persons' parking place in Lower Marsh.

Objections are invited - see paragraph 7.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make The Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons') (Limited Time) (No. *) Order 2019, under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. In brief, the general effect of the Order would be to provide a new disabled persons parking place in that length of Lower Marsh which lies on the south side, 8.2 metres west of Baylis Road for a distance of 6.6 metres.

3. The disabled persons' parking place would operate at any time and would be available for use only by vehicles which display in the relevant position a valid disabled persons' blue badge issued by a local authority for periods of not more than 30 minutes, vehicles would not be able to return to the disabled persons' parking place within 1 hour of leaving it.

4. The Order is necessary to improve parking facilities for people with disabilities and to assist in regulating parking.
