

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2205 GLA ROAD (BERMONDSEY STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place on Bermondsey Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on Bermondsey Street between its junction with Cruciflx Lane and Magdalen Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 25th January 2019 and 30th April 2019 every Monday to Friday from 9:00 PM to 05:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

The Order will permit all vehicles to turn right from Queen Elizabeth Street Tooley Street and use the westbound Bus Lane on Tooley Street between its junction with Queen Elizabeth Street and Potters Field.

The Order will allow two way operation on Tooley Street between its junction with Queen Elizabeth Street and Potters Field.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Snowfields, Weston Street, Long Lane, Bermondsey Street, Decima Street, Tower Bridge Road, Jamaica Road, Queen Elizabeth Street, Tooley Street and return to normal route of travel.
