### THE GLA ROADS AND GLA SIDE ROADS (WESTMINSTER) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2008 THE VARIOUS ROADS (ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING POINTS) VARIATION ORDER 2019

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to:

#### In Lewisham

- (1) Introduce a 24/7 bay for the charging of electric vehicles only outside Nos. 2-4 Clifton Rise;
- (2) Shorten the existing parking bay outside Nos.2-4 Clifton by 6 metres.

#### In Westminster

- (3) Introduce a 24/7 bay for the charging of electric taxi only on Achilles Way nearest junction with Park Lane Eastern Arm;
- (4) remove the existing loading bay on Achilles Way nearest junction with Park Lane Eastern Arm;

#### In Greenwich

- (5) Introduce a 24/7 bay for the charging of electric vehicles only outside No.13 Greenwich High Road;
- (6) Shorten the existing loading Bay outside No.13 Greenwich High Road by 6 metres.
