

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – BRIXTON STATION
ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Brixton Station Road which lies between its junction with Brixton Road and the western kerb-line of Popes Road.

2. Alternative routes will not be applicable.

3. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 21st May 2019 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect for about 10 days between 8 am and 5 pm on Mondays to Fridays but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum period of 2 months.
