### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – NURSERY ROAD FOR BRIDGE INSPECTION WORKS**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable detailed bridge inspection works to be carried out to the railway bridge over Nursery Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Nursery Road which lies between Ferndale Road and No. 21 Nursery Road.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles will be available via (i) Ferndale Road, Pulross Road, Bellefields Road, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road, Effra Road, St Matthews Road, Brixton Hill, Brixton Road, Brighton Terrace, Bernay's Grove, Tunstall Road and Shannon Grove; and (ii) Shannon Grove, Tunstall Road, Bernay's Grove, Brighton Terrace, Brixton Road and Ferndale Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order will come into force on 30th May 2019 and will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order will only have effect between 10 pm and 6 am on 30th and 31st May 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order will also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
