## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE A3 GLA ROAD (BOROUGH HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2019

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is, because of the likelihood of danger to the public, certain classes of traffic should be prohibited from making certain movements on Borough High Street.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except buses, cycles and taxis travelling in a southerly direction on Borough High Street to turn left into Duke Street Hill. The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on 17th May 2019 until 11:59 PM on the 15th May 2020 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
   Any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire
  - brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
    (2) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
  - (2) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Great Dover Street, Long Lane, Bermondsey Street and Tooley Street to normal route of travel.
