- Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to:
 - a) Remove the 8 metre Parking bay outside Nos. 36 to 38 Bromley Road and replace with Double Red Lines 'No Stopping at Any Time';
 - b) Shorten the existing 31 metre Loading bay on the western side of Willshaw Street by 11 metres at it southern end and introduce a Doctors Vehicle bay operating Mon-Sat 7am-7pm.
- The roads which would be affected by the Order are the A21 GLA Roads -Bromley Road and the A2 GLA Side Road – Willshaw Street in the London Borough of Lewisham.
