

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for Grant of Premises Licence

KEMI AKINOLA has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence in respect of the following premises: Brixton People's Kitchen cafe, 5 Beaufoy Walk, Kennington, SE11 7QE, which would authorise the following licensable activities: Supply of alcohol 12-10pm weekdays - 9pm Saturdays - 6pm Sundays; Films 12-9pm Everyday; Live music 12-10pm weekday, 12-9pm Saturdays, 12-5pm Sundays; Recorded music 10-9pm weekdays and Saturdays, 12-5 Sundays; Performances of dance 5-9pm weekdays, weekends 12-5pm.

The record of this application may be inspected during normal office hours at the Licensing Section, London Borough of Lambeth, 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG, or via the licensing authorities website at www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing.

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address or by email to licensing@lambeth.gov.uk and must be received no later than 06/11/2019.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licence application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
