

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – FLAXMAN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable railway bridge inspection works to be carried out by Network Rail, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intends to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Flaxman Road which lies between Coldharbour Lane and a point 10 metres north of Coldharbour Lane; and.
- (b) suspend the one-way traffic system in the length of Flaxman Road that lies between Coldharbour Lane and Pomfret Road, to enable access to and egress from properties in that length of Flaxman Road.

2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Coldharbour Lane and Pomfret Road.

3. The road closure and suspension of the one-way traffic system described above would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing, or covering, of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 18th October 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect from 10 pm on Friday 18th October 2019 until 6 am on Saturday 19th October 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time, then the Order may have effect at other times within the maximum duration of 1 month.
