

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE MANDRELL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Mandrell Road which lies between a point 33 metres east of Lyham Road and No. 2 Mandrell Road.
2. The above road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Lyham Road, Mauleverer Road and Strathleven Road and vice versa.
4. The Order would come into force on 12th November 2019 and would continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out on 12th and 13th November 2019 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may have effect on subsequent dates during the maximum period of 1 month.
