ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA ROADS (SOUTHWARK) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 A202 CAMBERWELL CHURCH STREET AND CAMBERWELL ROAD VARIATION ORDER 2019

1. Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to:
 - (1) convert the Loading Bay outside Nos. 18-19 Denmark Hill (operating between 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Anyday), to a shared use bay with Taxi Rank operating from 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM Anyday;
 - (2) convert the Loading Bay outside Nos. 4-6 Camberwell Church Street (operating between 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Mon-Sat) to a shared use bay with Taxi Rank operating from 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM Mon-Sat;
 - (3) remove the Licensed Taxi Rank Bay located outside Nos. 20 to 22 Camberwell Green;
 - (4) introduce double red lines where the Taxi Rank Bay is being removed (in article 3 above);

The roads which would be affected by the Order are GLA Roads the A202 Camberwell Church Street and Camberwell New Road, the A215 Camberwell Green and Denmark Hill.
3. A copy of the Order, a statement of Transport for London's reasons for the proposals, a map indicating the location and effect of the Order and copies of any Order revoked, suspended or varied by the Order can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, to make the application for the purpose for the challenge to the High Court..
