

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
INTRODUCTION OF A 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT IN PART
OF MITCHAM LANE

(Note: This notice is about the making of an Order to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on vehicles using part of Mitcham Lane.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 4th December 2019 made the Lambeth (20 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1, 2016) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2019 under sections 84(1) and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Order will come into force on 16th December 2019.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to impose a 20 mph maximum speed limit on motor vehicles proceeding in that length of Mitcham Lane which lies between Campbell Close and the boundary of the London Borough of Wandsworth at the bridge over the railway.

3. The majority of the roads in the London Borough of Lambeth, except for those roads subject to Red Route controls, are already subject to a 20 mph maximum speed limit. The Order is necessary to include Mitcham Lane within the existing 20 mph speed limit area with the intention of reducing traffic speeds and improving road safety for all road users.
