ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS - ROBSON ROAD FOR THAMES WATER TRUNK MAINS REPLACEMENT WORKS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water to carry out trunk mains replacement works in and close to Norwood Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering or waiting in that length of Robson Road which lies between Norwood Road and a point 3 metres north-east of the party wall of Nos. 1a and 1d Robson Road (approximately 70 metres).

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. Alternative routes would be available for vehicles affected by the road closure via Norwood Road, Lancaster Avenue, Thurlow Park Road, Rosendale Road and Robson Road and vice versa.

4. Whenever the bans referred to in paragraph 1 above apply the order that imposes the ban on buses entering that length of Park Hall Road which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Rosendale Road and the south-western kerb-lines of Croxted Road and South Croxted Road would be suspended.

5. The Order would come into force on 6th January 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 10 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
