ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (TANNER STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY 20 M.P.H SPEED LIMIT AND PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable cycle improvement works to take place on Tanner Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to:
 - 1) prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, stopping or proceeding into Tanner Street from Jamaica Road and Druid Street;
 - 2) prohibit any vehicle from entering Tanner Street from Druid Street in a westbound or southbound direction;
 - 3) prohibit any vehicle from proceeding into Druid Street between its junctions with Tanner Street and Coxson Way;
 - 4) suspend the One Way restriction on Druid Street between Abbey Street and Tanner Street. Local access only will be allowed;
 - 5) suspend the One Way restriction on Arnold Estate. Local access only will be allowed.

This order also restricts all vehicles from exceeding a speed limit of 20 M.P.H.

Works will be phased such that not all restrictions may apply at any one time.

The Order will be effective each day between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM from 19th January 2020 until 31st March 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Abbey Street, Druid Street, Tanner Street and Tower Bridge Road and to normal routes of travel.
