

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE
CLAPHAM MANOR STREET AND PRESCOTT PLACE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable new telecommunication connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be at certain times to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of:-

(a) Clapham Manor Street which lies between Clapham High Street and a point 15 metres north-west of Clapham High Street (alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (i) Clapham High Street, Edgeley Road and Voltaire Road and vice versa; and (ii) Clapham High Street, Stonhouse Street and Cresset Street and vice versa);

(b) Prescott Place which lies between Clapham High Street and a point 10 metres north-west of Clapham High Street (alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (i) Clapham High Street, Clapham Manor Street and Cresset Street and vice versa; and (ii) Clapham High Street, Stonhouse Street and Cresset Street and vice versa).

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The order would come into force on 10th February 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out in 2 phases between 10th and 16th February 2020, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order would also have effect on subsequent dates.
