ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A201 GLA ROAD (BLACKFRIARS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable sewer cleansing works to take place on the A201 GLA Road Blackfriars Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning right into The Cut from Blackfriars Road. Access will be maintained for cyclists.

The Order will be effective each night from 9:00 PM on 14 th February 2020 until 1:00 AM on 21 st February 2020 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: (for westbound traffic via Southwark Street and Waterloo Road and to normal route of travel), (for southbound traffic via Blackfriars Road, St Georges Roundabout, London Road, Garden Row, St Georges Road, Westminster Bridge Road and Baylis Road and to normal route of travel).
