

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3214 GLA ROAD (BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is for installation of telecoms chambers and ducts works to take place on A3214 Buckingham Palace Road in the City of Westminster.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in the northbound contraflow bus lane on Buckingham Palace Road between its junctions with the north-western arm of Grosvenor Gardens and the western arm of Grosvenor Gardens.
The Order will be effective between 18th January 2020 and 26th January 2020, every Saturday at 8:00 AM until Sunday at 4:00 PM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Grosvenor Gardens, Lower Grosvenor Place and Buckingham Palace Road to normal route of travel.
