 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Gleneldon Road, Bournevale Road and Stanthorpe Road; and (ii) Stanthorpe Road, Gleneagle Road, Ambleside Avenue, Garrad's Road, Becmead Avenue, Streatham High Road and Gleneldon Road.
- The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
 The Order would come into force on 6th July 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 5 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between

6th and 9th July 2020 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed in that time then the Order may have effect on subsequent days up to the maximum period of 5

months.
