ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND "AT ANY TIME" PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN HAMILTON ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from:-(a) entering that length of Hamilton Road which lies

(a) entering that length of Hamilton Road which lies between Gipsy Road and a point 34.5 metres northwest of Gipsy Road;

(b) waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of Hamilton Road which lies between Gipsy Road and Paxton Place.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Gipsy Road and Paxton Place; and (ii) Gipsy Road, Auckland Hill, St Cloud Road, St Gothard Road and Carnac Street and vice versa.
3. The road closure and ban on parking and waiting by vehicles would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 22nd June 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 5 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner
