ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A41, A501, A3214 GLA ROADS (BAKER STREET, PARK ROAD, MARYLEBONE ROAD, BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD, VICTORIA STREET, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to introduce social distancing measures on or near sections of the A41 Baker Street, A41 Park Road, A501 Marylebone Road, A3214 Buckingham Palace Road and A3214 Victoria Street because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the coronavirus pandemic.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping:
 - (1) at any time in the Loading and Unloading Bay outside No. 207 Victoria Street;
 - (2) at any time in the Loading and Unloading Bay opposite No. 174 Marylebone Road (outside the Old Marylebone Town Hall);
 - (3) at any time in the Loading and Unloading Bay outside Nos. 15 to 17 Marylebone Road (outside Ferguson House);
 - (4) at any time in the Loading and Unloading Bay outside No. 20 Marylebone Road (outside the London Clinic);
 - (5) at any time in the Taxi Rank Bay and Coach Stand opposite Nos. 29 to 40 Marylebone Road (outside Madame Tussauds);
 - (6) at any time in the Loading Bay/Bus Cage outside No. 2 Park Road;
 - (7) at any time in the Loading Bay outside No. 187 Baker Street.The Order will be effective at certain times from 12.01 AM on 22nd June 2020 until 11:59 PM on 23rd December 2021 or when the social distancing measures are not required, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
