

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA ROAD (VAUXHALL BRIDGE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow a crane operation to take place on Vauxhall Bridge Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on Vauxhall Bridge Road northwest bound between its junctions with Drummond Gate and Rampayne Street.
The Order will also suspend the south-western footway of Vauxhall Bridge Road between its junctions with Drummond Gate and Rampayne Street.
The Order will be effective between on 9:30 AM on 27th June 2020 and 4:30 PM on 28th June 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Drummond Gate, Bessborough Street, Lupus Street, St George's Square, Belgrave Road, Denbigh Street and Wilton Road to normal route of travel. For vehicles over 18T via John Islip Street, Bulinga Street, Herrick Street, Marsham Street, Horseferry Road, Greycoat Place and Rochester Row to normal route of travel.
