

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS IN BEDFORD**  
**ROAD, CONCANON ROAD, SANDMERE ROAD,**  
**SANTLEY STREET AND TINTERN STREET**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of a likelihood of danger to the public due to an increase in pedestrians and pedal cyclists using certain roads following restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban all vehicles in Bedford Road, except pedal cycles, from entering Sandmere Road;
- (b) ban the right turn by vehicles, except pedal cycles, from Sandmere Road into Bedford Road;
- (c) ban the right turn by vehicles, except pedal cycles, from Bedford Road into Tremadoc Road;
- (d) ban vehicles in Bedford Road, between Sandmere Road and Tremadoc Road, from making a U-turn;
- (e) ban motor vehicles in Santley Street from entering Concanon Road and motor vehicles in Concanon Road from entering Santley Street; and
- (f) ban motor vehicles in Tintern Street from entering Sandmere Road and motor vehicles in Sandmere Road from entering Tintern Street.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above restrictions will be available via adjacent roads.

3. The temporary traffic restrictions described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 27th July 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months.
