ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND "AT ANY TIME" PARKING, WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS HEYBRIDGE AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable gas main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering, parking and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in that length of Heybridge Avenue which lies between Streatham High Road and Copley Park (both sides of the road).

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Copley Park, Baldry Gardens and Braxted Park and vice versa; (b) Braxted Park, Strathbrook Road and Fontaine Road; and (c) Heybridge Avenue, Fontaine Road, Hilldown Road and Streatham High Road and vice versa.

3. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 3rd August 2020 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
