- which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering, parking and waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle) at any time in that length of Heybridge Avenue which lies between Streatham High Road and Copley Park (both sides of the road).

2 Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be

- available via (a) Copley Park, Baldry Gardens and Braxted Park and vice versa; (b) Braxted Park, Strathbrook Road and Fontaine Road; and (c) Heybridge Avenue, Fontaine Road, Hilldown Road and Streatham High Road and vice versa
- 3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 3rd August 2020 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been
