KNAPMILL ROAD – PROVISION OF WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND LOADING BAY

The Lewisham (Charged-For Parking Places)
(Amendment No. 39) Order 2020

The Lewisham (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and
Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions)
(Amendment No. 35) Order 2020

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council on 24th July 2020 made the above-mentioned Orders under the powers of sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders will be in **Knapmill Road**, in connection with the reconstruction of the carriageway and footway opposite and south of the junction of Knapmill Road with the unnamed access road linking Knapmill Road with Brookehowse Road:
 - (a) to provide a loading bay operating ‘at any time’ inset to the south-east side of the main carriageway on the east side of **Knapmill Road**, extending for approximately 7 metres south of the southern boundary of No. 195 Knapmill Road; and
 - (b) to provide ‘at any time’ waiting and loading restrictions on both sides of **Knapmill Road**, from 1 metre north of the southern boundary of No. 195 Knapmill Road, extending south-westwards to a point 1 metre west of the eastern boundary of No. 3 Broadmead, excluding that length where the loading bay referred to in paragraph (a) above will be provided. [Note: There are existing ‘at any time’ waiting restrictions in part of the length of road specified in this paragraph].

4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
