## **Transport for London Notice**

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE A3 GLA ROAD (CLAPHAM HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to introduce social distancing measures on or near sections of the A3 Clapham High Street, because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the coronavirus pandemic.
- 3. The effect of the Order will also to remove the loading, unloading and disabled persons' vehicles bay outside Nos. 157 to 161 Clapham High Street and replace with double red lines (no stopping at any time). The Order will be effective each day from 12.01 AM on 15th July 2020 until 11:59 PM on 13th January 2022 or when the social distancing measures are no longer required, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
