ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A302 GLA ROAD (GROSVENOR GARDENS, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow telecommunication works to take place on Grosvenor Gardens.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle proceeding on Grosvenor Gardens from turning right into Lower Grosvenor Place eastbound.
 - The Order will be effective from 10:00 PM on 15th August 2020 until 6:00 AM on 16th August 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Grosvenor Place, Piccadilly, Duke of Wellington Place and Grosvenor Place to normal route of travel.
