## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A23 GLA BOAD (STREATHAM HIGH B

THE A23 GLA ROAD (STREATHAM HIGH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND REMOVAL OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2020

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to introduce social distancing measures on or near sections of the A23 Streatham High Road, because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to the coronavirus pandemic.
- 3. The effects of the Order will be to:
  (1) remove the loading and unloading bay outside Nos. 374-380
  - Streatham High Road replacing it with double red lines (no stopping at any time);
    (2) remove the north-westbound bus lane on the A23 Streatham High
    - Road between its Junction with Station Approach and opposite No.4 Hopton Parade, Streatham High Road.

      The Order will be effective at certain times from 12.01 AM on 11th July.

2020 until 11:59 PM on 10th January 2022 or when the social distancing measures are not required, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
