## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A202 GLA ROADS (VAUXHALL BRIDGE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER AND LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable waterproofing, resurfacing and repaving works to take place on Vauxhall Bridge.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on Vauxhall Bridge/ Bridgefoot between their junctions with Millbank/ Grosvenor Road and Albert Embankment/ Wandsworth Road. The Order will also:
  - suspend the northwest-bound and southeast-bound bus lanes on Vauxhall Bridge/ Bridgefoot between their junctions with Millbank/ Grosvenor Road and Albert Embankment/ Wandsworth Road:
  - (2) suspend the cycle track on Vauxhall Bridge/ Bridgefoot between its junctions with Millbank/ Grosvenor Road and Albert Embankment/ Wandsworth Road:
  - (3) suspend the north-eastern and south-western footways of Vauxhall Bridge/ Bridgefoot between their junctions with Millbank/ Grosvenor Road and Albert Embankment/ Wandsworth Road.

The Order will at times permit buses/coaches/pedal cycles and pedestrians to proceed on Vauxhall Bridge, this will only apply at such times as indicated by traffic signs.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 8:00 PM on the 2nd August 2020 until 11:59 PM on the 26th March 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes and vehicles associated with the cleaning of the carriageway;
    - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Albert Embankment, Lambeth Bridge and Millbank or reverse to normal route of travel or via Grosvenor Road, Chelsea Bridge, Queenstown Road, Queen's Circus, Queenstown Road, Battersea Park Road, Nine Elms Lane and Wandsworth Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
