

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – TRENCHOLD
STREET AND WYVIL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering Trenchold Street (there is no alternative route available as Trenchold Street is a no through route, however access to and egress from properties in Trenchold Street would be maintained, when the works allow it);
- (b) ban vehicles from entering that length of Wyvil Road which lies between Luscombe Way and a point 16 metres east of Trenchold Street (alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (i) Wandsworth Road, Bridgefoot, Kennington Lane and South Lambeth Road; (ii) South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and Wandsworth Road; and (iii) Wandsworth Road, Lansdowne Way and South Lambeth Road and vice versa).

2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. The Order would come into force on 21st November 2020 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect on 21st and 22nd November 2020 with back up dates on 28th and 29th November but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect on other days during the maximum duration of 3 months.
