FRANKHAM STREET – SHARED USE PARKING PLACES CHANGES AND PROVISION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGE POINTS

The Lewisham (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

The Lewisham (Free Parking places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Borough Council propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under the powers of sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Orders would be to remove two shared use parking places and introduce two electric vehicle charge point parking places on the north side of **Frankham Street**, between a point 8 metres east of the western building wall of **Nos. 82 to 150 Giffin Street** and a point 13 metres east of that western building wall.
3. The new electric vehicle charge point parking places specified in paragraph 2 would only be for the use of electric vehicles that are charging and would be restricted 'At any time'.
4. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders are available for inspection by the public. For reasons connected to the effects of coronavirus, the Council considers that it would not be reasonably practicable to make these documents available for inspection in person. 5. Any objection or other representations relating to the proposed must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and must be emailed to: parkingdesign@lewisham.gov.uk or posted to Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, 5th Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU, quoting reference 'Frankham Street – TMO' to arrive not later than 21 days from the date of publication of this notice. Any objection may be communicated to other persons who may be affected.
