ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON HILL, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow gas works to take place on Brixton Hill.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons vehicle bay outside Nos.262-264 Brixton Hill;
 - (2) stopping on the Brixton Hill eastern kerb line between a point opposite the common boundary of Nos.254a and 256 Brixton Hill and Brixton Hill Place.

The Order will also permit all vehicles to use the southbound bus lane on Brixton Hill between Nos.254a and 256 Brixton Hill and Holmewood Road.

The Order will be effective between on 8:00 AM on 19th October 2020 and 6:00 PM on 22nd October 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
