

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING
RESTRICTIONS PLATO ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the erection of scaffolding to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) impose a one-way system in that length of Plato Road which lies between Acre Lane and No. 10 Plato Road, in a north-westerly direction (towards Kepler Road);
- (b) ban vehicles entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading and unloading a vehicle) in that length of the east side of Plato Road (the south bound carriageway) which lies between Acre Lane and No. 10 Plato Road.

2. An alternative route for affected vehicles would be available via Acre Lane, Solon Road and Kepler Road and vice versa.

3. The bans and one-way system would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 4th January 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
