ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC SYSTEM FOR CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING WORKS IN BLACK PRINCE ROAD, BRIXTON STATION ROAD, MOUNT EPHRAIM ROAD AND SOUTH ISLAND PLACE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth has made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:-

- (1) ban vehicles from entering Black Prince Road (a) between Vauxhall Street and Newburn Street; (b) between Newburn Street and Hotspur Street; and (c) between the common boundary of Nos. 21 and 23 Black Prince Road and Kennington Road (vehicles will also be temporarily banned from entering or leaving Hotspur Street at its junction with Black Prince Road); (Note: Only one of these sections of Black Prince Road will be closed at a time.)
- (2) suspend the one-way traffic systems in Brixton Station Road, between Popes Road and Barrington Road;
- (3) ban vehicles from entering Mount Ephraim Road, between Streatham High Road and Blakemore Road (vehicles will also be temporarily banned from entering or leaving Blakemore Road at its junction with Mount Ephraim Road); and
- (4) ban vehicles from entering South Island Place (the whole length).

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above road closures will be available via adjacent roads as indicated by traffic signs.

3. The road closures and the suspension of the one-way traffic systems described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing or covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 15th February 2021 and continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
