

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**CHANGES TO PARKING PLACES AND WAITING**  
**RESTRICTIONS IN MONTFORD PLACE**

*(NOTE: This Notice is about the extension of a length of existing shared use residents' and pay by phone parking space adjacent to a dropped kerb that is being removed and the reduction of a length of shared use residents' and pay by phone parking space further along this stretch of road and replacing it with at any time waiting restrictions (indicated by double yellow lines) to enable the construction of two new dropped kerbs to enable vehicular access to a new development.)*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 24th February 2021 made the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2021 and the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 300) Order 2021 under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders will come into force on 1st March 2021.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be in Montford Place on the west side to:-

(a) reinstate a redundant vehicular crossover and extend the adjacent shared use residents' and pay by phone parking place;

(b) reduce the length of an existing shared use residents' and pay by phone parking place opposite No. 20 Montford Place and ban waiting at any time (indicated by double yellow lines) in that length of road instead.

3. The Orders are required to (a) remove a length of parking space adjacent to two dropped kerbs in Montford Place so as to allow vehicular access and egress to properties; and (b) provide new parking space where a dropped kerb is being removed.

A copy of each of the Orders and other documents giving detailed particulars about them (including a map) would usually be made available for inspection at: the offices of Lambeth Council's Highways Team (Resident Services), 3 rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG, until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made. 6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
