

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – WYVIL ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering Wyvil Road (this will include banning vehicles in Trenchold Street and Luscombe Way from entering Wyvil Road). However, there will be an exception for vehicles gaining access to or egress from properties in Luscombe Way, as and when directed by traffic marshals.

2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above road closure will be available via (a) Wandsworth Road, Lansdowne Way and South Lambeth Road and vice versa; and (b) Wandsworth Road, Kennington Lane and South Lambeth Road; and (c) South Lambeth Road, Parry Street and Wandsworth Road.

3. The road closure described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 1st March 2021 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner, although in practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect for about 12 days.
