

# Transport for London Notice

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### THE A3205 AND A217 GLA ROADS (BATTERSEA PARK ROAD, YORK ROAD, ARMOURY WAY AND RAM STREET LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow cycle super highway works to take place on the A3205 and A217 Battersea Park Road, York Road, Armoury Way and Ram Street.
3. The effects of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from;
  - (1) Entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Battersea Park Road/ York Road westbound between its junctions with Queenstown Road and Wandsworth Roundabout;
  - (2) Entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on York Road/Battersea Park Road eastbound between its junctions with Wandsworth Roundabout and Latchmere Road;
  - (3) Entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Battersea Park Road eastbound between its junctions with Latchmere Road and Queenstown Road;
  - (4) Entering, proceeding or stopping on Ram Street between its junctions with Armoury Way and Wandsworth High Street;
  - (5) Stopping on the north-east side of Armoury Way between its junctions with Putney Bridge Road and Frogmore.

The Order will be effective between 22nd February 2021 and 8th August 2021 every night from 9:00 PM until 05:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via **(for the closure of westbound Battersea Park Road/York Road)** Wandsworth Road, South Lambeth Road, Clapham Road, Clapham High Street, Long Road, Clapham Common Northside, The Avenue, Clapham Common Westside, Battersea Rise, Northside Wandsworth Common Huguenot Place, East Hill, Wandsworth High Street, Wandsworth Plain, Armoury Way, Swandon Way to a normal route of travel. **(for the closure of eastbound York Road/Battersea Park Road)** Trinity Road, Trinity Road up slip, East Hill, Marcilly Road, North Side Wandsworth Common, Battersea Rise, Clapham Common Northside, Long Road, Clapham Common Southside, Clapham High Street, Clapham Road, South Lambeth Road, Parry Street to normal route of travel. **(for the closure of eastbound Battersea Park Road)** Battersea Bridge Road, Chelsea Embankment, Chelsea Bridge, Queenstown Road back to the normal route of travel. **(for the closure of Ram Street)** Armoury Way, Fairfield Street, Wandsworth High Street to normal route of travel.
