ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3200 GLA ROAD (STAMFORD STREET, LONDON BOROUGHS OF LAMBETH AND SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place on the A3200 Stamford Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from, entering, exiting or proceeding on:
 - (1) Stamford Street between its junctions with Waterloo Road and Broad Wall;
 - (2) Stamford Street between its junctions with Broad Wall and Blackfriars Road.

The Order will be effective each night from 9:00 PM on the 25th February 2021 until 06:00 AM on 19th April 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Waterloo Road, Westminster Bridge Road, Blackfriars Road, Lambeth Road, St. George's Road and then to normal route of traffic.
