

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE SHRUBBERY ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable utility connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Shrubbery Road which lies between Streatham High Road and the party wall of Nos. 55 and 57 Shrubbery Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via (i) Streatham High Road and Gleneldon Road; and (ii) Gleneldon Road, Valley Road, Sunnyhill Road and Streatham High Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order would come into force on 10th May 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be carried out in 2 phases so that it would not apply to the whole length of Shrubbery Road specified in paragraph 1 above at any one time and that access for residents would be maintained throughout the works where possible.
