Annex 3 - There shall be no admittance to the premises after midnight on Fridays and Saturdays days.

Amendment of conditions

Annex 2 - Any alcohol, purchased within the premises, must be consumed by 02:00 hrs. to be changed to 03:00hrs.

Seasonal Variation

Any date preceding a Bank Holiday until 02:00, to be changed to 03:00.

Change of opening hours

Thurs 10:00-01:30, Fri-Sat 10:00-03:30, Sun 12:00-01:30.

Anyone wishing to oppose the application must give notice in writing to Licensing Authority, London Borough of Lewisham, Holbeach Office, 9 Holbeach Road, SE6 4TW or email licensing@lewisham.gov.uk within 28 days of the date of this notice, specifying the grounds of opposition. The application can also be viewed at the above address during office hours.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application. The maximum fine on summary conviction is £5,000.

Should representation be received a public hearing will be held.
