ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A4 GLA ROAD (BROMPTON ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON & CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable resurfacing works to take place on A4 Brompton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) Entering, exiting or proceeding northbound on A4 Brompton Road between its junctions with Sloane Street and Knightsbridge Green
 - (2) Entering, exiting or proceeding southbound on A4 Brompton Road between its junctions with Sloane Street and Knightsbridge GreenWorks will be phased such that not all restrictions may apply at any one time.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 18th April 2021 until 29th April 2021 every night from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Kensington Road, Kensington Gore, Queens Gate, Brompton Road to normal route of travel.
