

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY FOOTWAY AND ROAD CLOSURE -**  
**ELECTRIC LANE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable cladding removal works to be carried out in Electric Lane, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban any:-

(a) vehicle from entering that length of Electric Lane which lies between Coldharbour Lane and the south-west side of the entrance to the Reliance Arcade (approximately 35 metres north of Coldharbour Lane);

(b) pedestrian from entering that length of the north-eastern footway of Electric Lane which lies between Coldharbour Lane and party wall of Nos. 21 and 23 Electric Lane (approximately 19 metres north of Coldharbour Lane).

2. The above road and footway closures will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

3. An alternative route will be available for affected motor vehicles via Electric Avenue, Atlantic Road, Brixton Road, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road, Effra Road, St Matthews Road, Brixton Hill and Coldharbour Lane.

4. Alternative routes for affected cyclists will be available via Electric Avenue, Atlantic Road and Coldharbour Lane and vice versa.

5. The Order will come into force on 28th June 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 12 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
