TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND ONE-WAY TRAFFIC SYSTEMS FOR

TELECOMMUNICATIONS WORKS IN HAILSHAM AVENUE, HILLSIDE ROAD. HITHERFIELD ROAD, KINFAUNS ROAD, KINGSMEAD ROAD, LANERCOST ROAD, LEIGHAM AVENUE, LYDHURST AVENUE, MOUNTEARL GARDENS, MOUNT NOD ROAD

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works to upgrade telecommunications infrastructure to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:a) ban vehicles from entering:-
 - Barcombe Avenue from its junction with Hillside Road;

 - (ii) Cricklade Avenue from its junction with Hillside Road;
 - (iii) Hillside Road, at its junction with the north-eastern kerb-line of Palace Road;
 - (iv) Hitherfield Road at its junction with Leigham Vale;
 - (v) Leigham Avenue between Streatham High Road and Woodleigh Gardens; and
- (vi) Stockfield Road from its junction with Mount Nod Road; b) impose a one-way traffic system in:-
 - Hailsham Avenue between Mount Nod Road and Amesbury Avenue in a south-
 - eastbound direction: (ii) Hillside Road between Amesbury Avenue and Cricklade Avenue in a northbound
 - direction; (iii) Hitherfield Road between Leigham Vale and Mount Nod Road in a north-
 - eastbound direction: (iv) Kinfauns Road between Kingsmead Road and Palace Road in a northbound direction:
 - (v) Kingsmead Road between Northstead Road and Kinfauns Road in a westbound direction;
 - (vi) Kingsmead Road between Northstead Road and the boundary of Nos. 46 and
 - 48 Kingsmead Road in an eastbound direction: (vii) Lanercost Road between Probyn Road and Lanercost Close in an eastbound
 - direction: (viii) Leigham Avenue between Streatham High Road and Woodleigh Gardens in a
 - westbound direction: (ix) Lydhurst Avenue, between Mount Nod Road and Faygate Road in a westbound
 - direction; (x) Mountearl Gardens between Adare Walk and Mount Nod Road in a northeastbound direction: and
 - (xi) Mount Nod Road between Hitherfield Road and Mountearl Gardens in a southwestbound direction.
- 2. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in
- paragraph 1 above, via adjacent streets as indicated by traffic signs.
- 3. The bans described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be

indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 28th June 2021 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the road closures and one-way traffic systems will only apply in phases as the works progress along the roads concerned and it is anticipated that all the works will be done over a 12 to 18-month period. Each street unit will be carried out in short phases of 3 to 5 days and will be coordinated to avoid diversions overlapping.
