ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – THE CUT

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to facilitate highways resurfacing works, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of The Cut which lies between its junction with Cornwall Road and its junction with Hatfields.
2. Alternative routes for vehicles affected by the above road closure would be available via Hatfields Stamford Street, Waterloo Road, The Cut and vice versa. Vehicular access to and egress from properties in The Cut would be permitted when it is reasonably practicable without inference with the works.
3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 21st June 2021 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order would only have effect for 5 days but if the works cannot be carried out or complete during that time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time or times within the maximum duration of 2 months.
