It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application. The maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction is £5,000.

Person objecting to the grant of licences must be prepared to attend in person at a hearing before a committee of the Council. NOTE: Your objection will form part of the committee report and forwarded to the applicant. Please let us know if you have a valid reason for your personal details to be removed.
