ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 INSIDE OUT LONDON 2021 (RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC IN CONNECTION WITH CERTAIN EVENTS) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice, that after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, the London Boroughs of Southwark and Tower Hamlets, and the Common Council of the City of London, it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 16(A)(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable the event known as "Inside Out London 2021" to take place.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on the A100 Tower Bridge Road/ Tower Bridge/ Tower Bridge Approach between its junctions with Bricklayers Arms Roundabout and East Smithfield, local access will be maintained on Tower Bridge Road between its junctions with Bricklayers Arms Roundabout and Queen Elizabeth Street. The Order will come into force between 6:00 AM on 13th June 2021 and 1:00 AM on 14th June 2021 or until normal traffic
- operation can be resumed, whichever is the sooner.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of those provisions would hinder the use of the vehicle:
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, or a person authorised by Transport for London:
 - (3) any vehicle used in conjunction with Inside Out London 2021 ("the Event").
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs.
