ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA SIDE ROAD A23 (WINDMILL ROW, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2021

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named, Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable Thames Water repair works to take place on Windmill Row.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering.
- exiting, proceeding or stopping on Windmill Row between its junctions with Kennington Park and Kennington Lane.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 8:00 AM on 7th June 2021 until 5:00 PM on 28th June 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs (for southbound traffic travelling from Kennington Road) via Kennington Park Road, Harleyford Street, Kennington Oval and Harleyford Road to normal route of travel or reverse via Durham Street. For northbound traffic travelling from

Kennington Road via Kennington Lane to normal route of travel.
