ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE LYHAM ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable utility connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Lyham Road which lies between the southern kerb-line of Prague Place and the northern kerb-line of Crescent Lane (approximately 25 metres).
2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Lyham Road, Kings Avenue, Thornbury Road and Lyham Road.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 12th July 2021 and would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. Access for residents would be maintained throughout the works where possible.
