Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Honor Oak Park, SE23)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of telecommunication works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Honor Oak Park, SE23 between Stondon Park and the western boundary of No.98 Stondon Park.
(2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via either (i) Honor Oak Park, Honor Oak Road, A205, Brockley Rise and Stondon Park, and vice versa, or (ii) Stondon Park, Brockley Road, Brockley Cross, Endwell Road, Mantle Road, St. Norbert Road, Brockley way, Brenchley Gardens, Forest Hill Road and Honor Oak Park, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 18th July 2021 to remain in force for up to 2 months.

(Note: The works and the closure are planned to be only on Sunday 18th July 2021.)

- 4.** The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
